Protection of information and data

The protection of business processes and internal information as well as data, even under difficult boundary conditions, is a central task of corporate management. Apart from the efforts of the BSI on "IT-Grundschutz" and ISO 27001, there has not been any sector-specific standardization on the requirements for information security for a long time.

However, the networking of business processes across company boundaries requires a comparable level of protection for all those involved. The TISAX model (Trusted Information Security Assessment Exchange) was therefore developed under the patronage of the VDA.

TISAX serves as a cross-company recognition of information security assessments and creates a common testing and exchange standard for this purpose. The operator of TISAX itself is the ENX Association, which has been entrusted with its implementation by the VDA as a neutral body.





Safety as the top priority

The VDA has been issuing a recommendation on information security requirements for companies in the Automotive Industry since 2005. The VDA Information Security Assessment (VDA ISA) is a questionnaire that can be used for a self-assessment and serves as basis for the TISAX-Assessment.

Insights into the requirements of information security as well as recommendations for action and the communication of best practices are the central components of a 2-day training course run by the VDA QMC. You will learn about the most important controls and understand the necessary steps to achieve your TISAX label.
